## Yemen-Based Disinformation Campaign Distributing Fake News in Israel and the Arab World

#### Summary

On July 25<sup>th</sup>, 2019, several social media profiles propagated fake news claiming that two famous Israeli women, Yona Elian And Roni Dalumi (an actor and a singer, respectively), have died. These accounts posted the story on Israeli media outlets pages, as well as a number of Israeli social media groups, primarily on Facebook.

Note that each of these posts shared a links to fake media outlets' websites. Investigating these websites Clearsky uncovered a large-scale disinformation campaign based in Yemen, operating since 2016. The operation is comprised of several dozen fake media outlets, impersonating legitimate Arab media outlets from the Gulf and the Arabian Peninsula.

Despite many grammatical and spelling errors and the gruesome content, the fake information went viral quickly and uncontrollably. Despite the promptly issued official denials of the news, it took a long time to refute them.

These sites bear many similarities to the global disinformation operation conducted by Iran for 7 years, which we exposed on November 2018<sup>1</sup>. Further, the operators of the Yemen-based campaign are using the exact same methodology as the Iranian operation. Accordingly, Clearsky assess that there might be a connection between these operators.

One possible connection is that the operators of this operation are related to the Houthi movement which has strong connections to the Iranian regime. While this attribution is still under investigation, it is clear that at the very least the Yemen operators were inspired from the Iranian operation.



#### Content in Hebrew alongside content in Arabic

In several of the fraudulent websites (all written in Arabic) we identified fake content in Hebrew. The reason for this remains unclear. The Hebrew content is mainly about famous Israeli celebrities. Note that some of content was copied of Israeli websites with minor changes.

For example, several of the fake articles were about the death of Israeli actor and Israeli singer. During the investigation, we identified few old articles distributed fake rumors about suicide attempts of Israeli actors that contained almost exact wording. Below is a screenshot from one of the fraudulent websites:



To distribute this fake news, the operators used fake social media accounts. Some of these accounts have the names of the fake media outlets, while others have names of genuine profiles with various changes (for example, Arabic names written in Hebrew).

Most of these accounts were blocked by Twitter and Facebook. However, some of them are still active and continue distributing fake news in Israel and in the Arab Peninsula. Regarding the profiles distributing the recent fake news, it appears that in some cases, the operators did not try to hide the origins of the profiles.

A few of the profiles' name were not change from the original name in Arabic to Hebrew names. In other cases, we observed minor and cosmetic changes. As noted, each post included a link for the fake news website.

One of the profiles targeting Israel went by the handle "**Eilat Takrit**" ('Eilat Incident' in Hebrew). The profile posted rumors about the alleged death of Yona Elian, alongside a link to the fake website encouraging the readers to access it. This account for instance, posted a comment with a link on the formal page of the Israeli public broadcasting, 'Kan' (כאו).




When looking at the profile's account the direct connection to Yemen becomes apparent. Notably, the profile claims to work in 'عمل خاص', a Yemeni business from Tarim, Yemen<sup>2</sup>. Moreover, while that account pretends to be of a young female, the operator of this profile did not remove the original profile pictures of it – presenting an adult **man**. The photos were uploaded by the profile owner on 2013. Respectively, its Facebook's friends are adult mans from Yemen.

The profile states that this woman lives in the city of Eilat, same as her name. Accordingly, we assess that the

operator of the profile adopted the name from the city.






#### **Digital Infrastructe**

The operation is comprised of tens of fake media outlets, most of which carry names associate with the Persian Gulf. Below are a few examples for these websites:



As seen in the above screenshots, the websites primarily deal with issues pertaining to the Persian Gulf (it should be noted that the word "Persian" is not mentioned at all, which can indicate of the origin of the operators<sup>3</sup>).

The most covered countries, based on our sample examination, are Saudi Arabia and Yemen. Other prominent countries are all from the Arab peninsula. In the third circle we identified Israel, The Palestinian Authority (without any mentions of Hamas and the Palestinian terror organizations), and other Arab countries (in most cases, referring to an issue within the Persian Gulf).

One peculiar pattern we identified is that some of websites had content in Hebrew, without a discernible purpose. The reason for it remains unclear. Only a few articles in Hebrew are relevant to the Gulf, while others are random articles in Hebrew.



Some of the websites indicate specific agendas. However, regarding the Hebrew content, it appears that the content was copied from other sources and was translated from Non-Hebrew language. The Hebrew articles were primarily about violent subjects such as rape and murder incidents.

The content of the articles in Arabic were copied from the Arabic version of popular media outlets such as RT and Sputnik. It should be noted that the operators of the Iranian global disinformation



#### Similarty to the Iranian Global Disinfromation Operation

This campaign bears many similarities to the long-running Global Disinformation Operation (GDO) executed by Iranian actors, exposed by Clearsky in 2018<sup>5</sup>. While there are currently no known technological connections, there is nevertheless a distinctive likeness between the two.

We assess that the operators of the Yemeni campaign were influenced by the GDO, or at the very least inspired by it. If the Yemeni operators are indeed from the Houthi movement, then there is a possibility (low-medium certainty) that the Iranian GDO operators instructed the Yemeni on how to establish and operate a large-scale disinformation operation.

Below a table summarize few comparisons and contrasts between the operations.

Similarities in the format of the domains' URL names. Each domain contains the name of the fake media outlet, most of them with hyphen in the domain name. The most common media outlets names contain the words "News" or "Press".

Shared targets – Saudi Arabia, The Persian Gulf, Yemen and Israel.

Distributing method via social media. The operators impersonated beautiful women to share the "juicy" information.

Each language used by the GDO were part of unique version of each website, without mixing between languages.

The Iranian narrative of the GDO is definite, unlike the Yemeni narrative. The exception of the Yemeni operation is reporting of death of Israeli famous celebrities.

In the GDO we successfully attributed the operation to Iran based on technological connection. In the Yemeni operation, also succeeded in attributing the operation to Yemen via the same methodology. However, as of writing this report we were unable to establish an indicative technological link between the two operations.

The fake profiles in the GDO were distinctive to the operation, unlike the Yemeni operation.
